World Water Day 2026

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As part of our school's commemoration of **World Water Day 2026**, our students will take part in a **water rationing exercise** in school on **30 March 2026** during recess.

2. This exercise aims to prepare students for potential water rationing situations when our country faces water shortages due to climate change. It also provides students with experiential learning to understand what it feels like to have limited access to clean water, helping them develop a deeper sense of responsibility towards water conservation in their daily lives.

3. Please note that only the **handwashing area at the canteen** will have its water supply disrupted. The water supply in the toilets and water coolers will remain fully operational. During the exercise, students will scoop water from pre-filled pails to wash their hands in the sinks at the canteen handwashing area. Soap will be provided as usual. After the exercise, students will reflect on their experiences and share their thoughts and feelings during a guided classroom discussion.

4. Parents/Guardians may wish to engage your child/ward in sharing his/her experience with you and reinforce the important notion that everyone has a part to play in water conservation.
